

# Pseudoweinmannia lachnocarpa (Rose Marara)

Buttressed tree. Leaves are in threes, opposite on the stem. White flowers on racemes about 5cm long in August [no petals on the flowers]. Fruit matures in February to April – ovate capsule covered in golden hairs. Leaves are tough, leathery and glossy on both sides.



**Type:** Tree to 15+m  
**Aspect:** Full Sun/Part Shade  
**Soil:** Moist, Fertile  
**Habitat:** Dry Sclerophyll
