

Senna acclinis (Brush/Rainforest Senna)

Rare shrub usually near rainforest edges. Leaves alternate, pinnate, to 15cm, discolorous. 30mm yellow flowers in spring to summer. The flowers are in group of 2-5 on a short stalk, hanging on the underside of the branchlets. Flat pod to 15cm x 5mm, not constricted between seeds, summer to autumn.



Type: Shrub to 3m
Aspect: Full Sun/Part Shade
Soil: Adaptable
Habitat: Rainforest Margins
