

Syncarpia glomulifera (Turpentine)

Tall, straight tree with fibrous, greyish trunk and fluffy white 5mm flowers in spring and summer. Woody seed capsule to 15mm ripen in summer. Leaves are opposite or whorled, hairy below. Crushed leaves have a taste and smell reminiscent of turpentine. Very hardy and makes an excellent windbreak.
