

Syzygium corynanthum (Sour Cherry)

Grows in moister rainforests. Leaves opposite, glossy to 12cm, paler below. White, 4-petaled flowers to 10mm, autumn to winter. Edible red fruit to 20mm in September to December. Bark is grey and scaly and tree is buttressed at the base.



Type: Tree to 15+m
