

## Syzygium crebrinerve (Purple Cherry)

Tree of moister rainforests. Young stems and new growth often red. Leaves opposite, glabrous, glossy, paler below to 14cm. Aromatic when crushed. White flowers, spring to summer. Edible pinkish-purple, slightly compressed fruit to 25mm. The bark is a grey/fawn colour. New live bark is a purplish brown colour.



**Type:** Tree to 15+m  
**Aspect:** Part Shade  
**Soil:** Well-drained  
**Habitat:** Dry Sclerophyll
