

# Syzygium francisii (Rose Satinash)

Large tree to 15m, usually less. Trunk is often patchy reddish/brown and very attractive. Shiny broad leaves to 6cm. Small white flowers in November to December, and bluish fruit ripening in January to April. Can be pruned. Hardy tree. Found along moist, scrubby watercourses.
