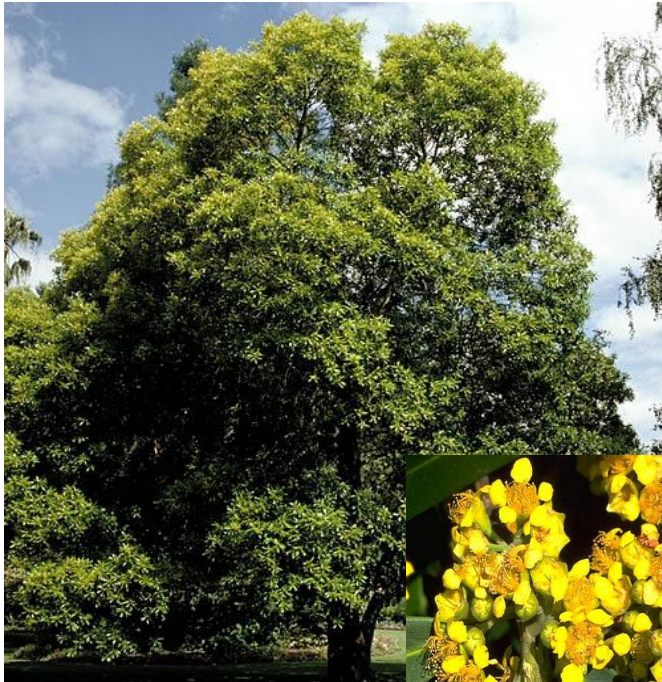


Tristaniopsis laurina (Water Gum)

This tree usually grows near the eastern coastline and along the banks of streams, where the trunks and branches tend to be shaped in the direction of the current and give an indication of the flood height. Attractive white, papery bark with glossy leaves to 10cm long. Bright yellow flowers (unpleasant odour to some) in spring to summer. Good tree for shaded wet spot.
