

Wilkiea macrophylla (Large-leaved Wilkiea)

Glossy, stiff, green leaf and yellow/green unpleasantly scented flowers in clusters in May to November. New leaves are maroon. Bark creamy grey, smooth to finely scaly. Stems hairless. Oblong black fruit in April to September. Good indoor plant. Most often seen as a sprawling understory shrub of around 2 metres.
